To whom it may concern,

I am Ray Del Bosque, Sheriff of Zapata County, Texas. As with all Sheriff's departments across the country, fuel and maintenance costs of our vehicles fleets has been a major expense from my budget. Ben Talamantez representative for ECO- Systems Fuel Enhancers came and explained how these units can reduce fuel consumption and lower maintenance cost to my staff and myself. Then we learned that this same device reduces emissions from harmful exhausted gases that was a major plus since out patrols spend many hours per day in their vehicles. With over 1000 square miles for my deputies to cover it is not uncommon to have to fill up twice a day covering the area 24/7. After testing the units on several of our Ford Explorer's, Chevrolet Tahoe's and Ford F350's with Power Stroke engines, our Deputies immediately noticed better performance with quicker throttle response, and best of all not having to fill up as often. After a couple of weeks we saw a 10 to 12 percent savings on our Tahoe's and on our Explorers 12 to 15 percent savings. At today's cost of fuel, the ROI is less than 90 days. The Ford Diesels have less Regens and a lot less issues with the DEF Fluid. Since we tested the units we have done out entire fleet, including out transfer Vans. I'm responsible to the taxpayers as to how we spend their money and the savings on fuel and maintenance costs is a great news. Extending the life of our equipment is another plus.
